KANGAROO MOTHER CARE FOUNDATION INDIA

- The first, non profit, voluntary service organization of India, dedicated to the promotion of Kangaroo Mother Care(KMC) including breast milk feeding as much as possible, care of low birth weight infants and related aspects of essential newborn care
- The coverage of activities all over India with a permanent central office in Ahmedabad, Gujarat

MISSION OF KMCF

To make Kangaroo Mother Care, a part of routine care of all the newborns, especially the low birth weight infants and not considered as a special extra intervention.

VISION OF KMCF

- * KMC is considered as the natural right of every baby and more so for the low birth weight newborns including preterm and IUGR babies and must be the gold standard of care as soon as possible after birth as frequently as possible and as long as possible.
- * KMC practice should become universal and reach almost all the newborns in our country, be they in hospitals or at home.
- * Baby to be kept in warmer/ incubator only when KMC is not possible
- * Zero separation of mother and baby
- * Mother's chest is the best place for baby care and mother's milk is the best food for baby's nutrition.

HISTORY OF KMC IN INDIA

- 1993-94 KMC introduced in India -B J Medical College, Ahmedabad, first KMC ward
- 1996-First KMC study from India -Trieste International Meeting on KMC
- 2002 -First National Workshop at AIIMS, New Delhi
- 2003 KMC India Network Six centers (New Delhi, Chandigarh, Mubai, Chennai, Jaipur, Lucknow)
- AIIMS- New Delhi produced first version of guidelines, training C.D., Poster
- KEM-Mumbai produced training material in English and local languages, good set up for KMC follow up
- 2005-Gujarati Module for home based KMC
- KMC included in training modules of central and state Governments of India
- 2012-9th International Conference of KMC, Ahmedabad, India
- 2013- KMC included in Government of Gujarat Policy, later in GO India Policy

ROLL OUT PLAN OF GOVERNMENT FOR KMC IN INDIA

- 2014 KMC accepted as an official policy-Operational guidelines prepared for KMC and optimal feeding of LBWI for service providers and program managers
- A National Collaborative Center for
- Technical assistance
- Capacity building and mentoring of regional/state level centers
- Developing technical guidelines and packages
- 2014 KMC included in India Newborn Action Plan INAP
- Recently in Sustainable Development Goals SDG
- Additional funds for KMC wards

WHY AN NGO IS NEEDED FOR KMC PROMOTION IN INDIA?

- Very large number of newborns to care for.
- Globally, The highest number of births >27 million per year
- The highest number of LBWI including preterm and IUGR >7.6million
- The highest number of newborn deaths due to easily preventable causes
- Hospital facilities including the SNCUs are much less than needed
- Simple interventions like KMC can save many LBWI
- KMC is a part of ENBC training- inadequate to develop confidence for proper implementation everywhere
- Professional bodies of doctors and nurses too busy with other activities to dedicate more time .KMC not included in pre service training
- Formation of KMCF dedicated to Promotion of KMC justified.

OBJECTIVES OF KMCF

- Increase awareness at all levels of society, behavior change communication and create demand generation, support and compliance for KMC
- Strengthen training and capacity building for hospital as well as home based KMC
- Improve the quality of practice of KMC and accelerate the coverage
- Conduct/support research studies of KMC relevant to our needs
- Encourage innovations, new ideas and actions for saving more newborns
- Improve networking with Government programs, International agencies and also KMC promotion groups at national and international levels
- Provide technical guidance, and create centers of excellence for KMC
- To start KMC resource center for India



- Exhibitions on IEC of KMC at several places


PROPOSED ACTIVITIES IN YEAR 2017
